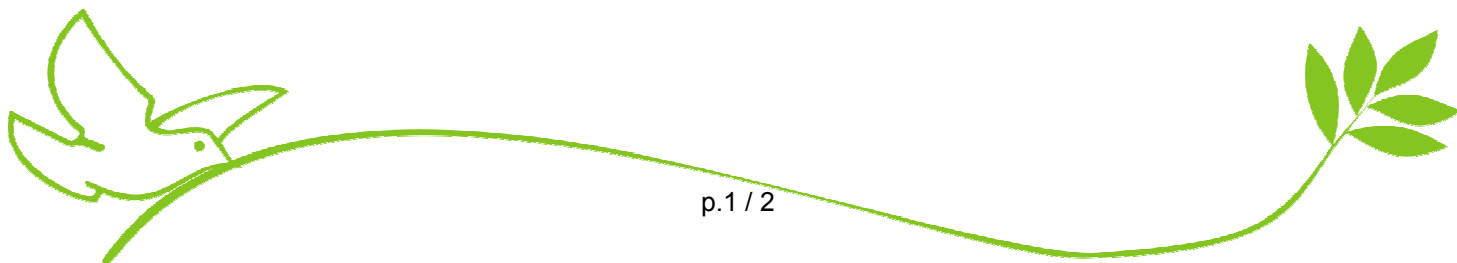

Evaluation:

- Time management was poor, some events were over-run, such as the ice-breaking and city trace.
- There was not enough time for debriefing and interaction between group members, so they could not consolidate what they had learnt from the activities.
- Instructions for games were not clear, even helpers did not familiarize with the games.
- The organizers had spent a lot of time on discussion, preparation and writing documents, but they were lack of practice and rehearsal, as they were not experienced in running formation programmes.
- All in all, the objectives were only partially achieved. There would be a follow-up gathering after the final examination.
